This funding will be used to

- Guarantee that every student will either:
 - Achieve their year level benchmarks in Literacy and Numeracy and/or
 - A My Education Plan will be implemented to address the specific learning needs of each individual.
- Increase attendance from 88% to 90% across the whole school.
- Increase the percentage of Prep students able to read and comprehend short, predictable texts and compose short meaningful sentences.
- Close the gap between Indigenous and Non-indigenous students with 100% retention of Year 10-12 students
- Maintain 100% of Year 12 students attaining a QCE/QCIA and VET II or higher qualification.
- Build staff capacity through ongoing professional development which is aligned with our school priorities.
- Support social and emotional wellbeing of students and staff to ensure successful engagement in school.

Our initiatives include

- Build Teacher capacity in Reading and consolidation in explicit instruction through coaching and mentoring.
- Develop Teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptors and achievement standards to ensure quality planning that addresses individual student needs.
- Develop Teachers' capacity to implement, monitor and review the My Education Plans ensuring at least one year's growth for one year's schooling for every student.
- Drive the Keeping Early Years in the Spotlight (K.E.Y.S) project across the whole of community to enhance the smooth transition to Prep and Year 1.
- Provide education for parents and early year's educators to support the development of oral language and early Literacy and Numeracy skills at home and school. This includes SSP training for staff and community.
- Strengthen the case management approach involving parents, school and community to support all students working towards a QCE or QCIA.
- Engage with service providers and organisations to support student and staff social and emotional wellbeing.
